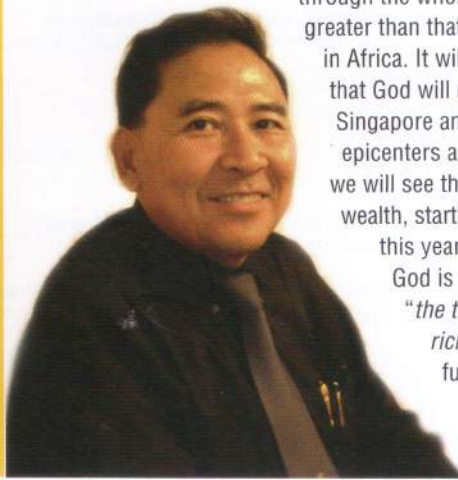

Introducing **GEORGE GUNTER**

Head, Covenant Vision Worship and Creative Arts Ministry

If you have been attending Covenant Vision meetings over the last few months, you couldn't have missed him. His presence is noticeable and his voice unmistakable. As a ministry, we have been blessed to have on board Bro George Gunter. Having finished his Certificate in Worship & Creative Arts and Diploma in Ministries at Hillsongs Church, Sydney Australia, he joined us in August 2007 to head the Worship and Creative Arts Ministry here at Covenant Vision. He was also the Worship Pastor of Full Gospel Assembly (FGA) for five years before heading down under. He shares with us his thoughts, feelings and vision for his new role here with us.

Bro George, why did you go to Australia to study at Hillsongs? And how was the experience?

I guess you could say that, I am still journeying in pursuit of excellence “..pressing on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus.” - (Phl:3:14). I sensed the calling of God on me to put aside what I was doing in FGA for the next two years as He wanted to minister to me. At first, no one could understand why I wanted to study – especially at the age of 53, and more so right after God had miraculously healed me of 4th stage cancer of the bladder in 2004.

How then did you come to join Covenant Vision (CV)?

The Word of God says, “We are assured and know that [God being a partner in Covenant Vision's labour], all things work together and are [fitting into a plan] for good to and for those *who love God and are called according to [His] design and purpose*” (Romans 8:28 Amp). We know that the earth didn't just happen without God. One morning whilst studying in Australia in a Touching Heaven Encounter during chapel, I saw the Glory of God reveal Himself in CV, through worship. How can it be... I asked myself?

In that vision I saw 'us' – the Team and together with Bro Francis, Pastor Henry, etc - their hands raised in worship. And in that moment as we reached upwards to God, I saw a '*membrane*' which was hanging over CV. As the membrane split, there was a sudden rush of Glory which saturated everything in its way, and as people heard the noise and saw what was happening, they ran towards the Glory and began to swim in it. “*So it will be in churches everywhere;*” a voice spoke into me, “*where the worship of God is given free reign, people will be drawn to God in great numbers.*” I truly believe my joining CV is part of God's divine plan and purpose breathed. **GLORY!!**



How have you been challenged in taking up this role?

As individuals, we are all very different thus, our approach to worship is also varied. I strongly believe that the form of worship is of minor importance, but our ATTITUDE is what counts with God. He looks for hearts filled with adoration and awe. I am COMMITTED to a process. God keeps working in our lives to conform us to the image of Christ (Rom 8:29). The greatest miracle He performs is a changed life. *Dante says that we are worms destined to be angelic butterflies.* This metamorphosis doesn't happen overnight; it takes time. Paul [in the Bible] was committed to the process of growing in character. His life-long, life-changing journey challenged him with a day-to-day commitment to die to self and follow God (Luke 9:23; John 12:24). Another challenge for me is to see a change in our culture of SERVANTHOOD. I love it when scripture says in Mark 10:45 that "even the Son of man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many." With this thought in mind, I could never give back to Him what He gave as a sacrifice for me. My availabilities are driven by God's abilities in me.

Galatians 5:13 tells us to "serve one another," and Romans 12:10 says to "be devoted to one another." Whenever we come to a meeting, or a rehearsal, we need to come ready to serve. Instead of always asking, "What's in it for me?" or "What can I get out of this?" we need to ask, "How can I serve? What can I give?"

What vision has God planted in your heart for the Worship and Creative Arts Ministry?

There is nothing more that I would desire than to come alongside with the Team and Covenant Vision and share this two year plan to:

1. Develop a level of excellence in playing and singing skills. (Dance & the arts at a later stage.)
2. Develop Practical Worship Workshops/Seminettes with topics such as 'Exemplifying Extravagant Worship' and 'Developing Personal Confidence'.
3. Plan and organise training, seminars, workshops, fellowships and establish/expand our networking outside Singapore.
4. "Music with a Mission", planned for 2008 – 2009, with the aim to equip, impact, inspire, influence in every sphere of worship
5. Teachings on Worship (Scripture Based).

What else can we expect in the future?

I have a passion for desired results with the aim and purpose to:

1. Be an effective ministry in pastoral, care, communication, prayer & intercession;
2. Evangelise the Gospel through Worship and the Arts, with real life testimonies and
3. Establish a fellowship of teaching ministries devoted to the promotion of Praise and Worship, Works and Word through Media and Arts.

By the grace of God, much will depend on how far we progress in the initial two years. Amen.



MINISTRY FOCUS

As we move into the tail-end of 2007 and look back on the events of the year, we recognise that if the Lord has ordained certain things, He would surely bring them to pass. Numbers 23:19a says, "Does He speak and then not act? Does He promise and not fulfill?".

In the beginning of this year, Bro Francis released the word of three waves of evangelistic fervour bringing revival in the magnitude that we have never seen before. In July this year, we ran the 'Hearing God' conference and a series of prophetic encounter meetings with Sis Teresa Seputis, founder of GodSpeak International and she released the Word that revival was coming to the whole of Asia, and that Singapore and Hong Kong were going to be Gateway Cities from which God was going to affect that revival. This further confirmed the word God released earlier to Bro Francis. For us as a ministry, we felt led to respond by asking God to allow us to be able to play a part in that coming revival.

As Bro Francis sought God for an answer and for His direction, he was led to our sanctuary at Covenant Vision Centre. There mounted on the wall was the answer. A plaque displaying the goals of our ministry: '**Equipping a Chosen Generation, Reaching Lost Nations, Transforming our World for Jesus**'. God was pointing us back to the objectives of the ministry He had impressed on Bro Francis' heart many years ago. As Bro Francis meditated on those three sentences, it gave him a fresh burst of enthusiasm. Everything once again became that much clearer.

As a ministry, we celebrated our 9th Anniversary on the 1st of July culminating in a dinner on the 9th of September this year. As we looked back at the growth of the ministry, especially in the last one year, we saw all that God had been moving us to do have been in line with these three goals. The 'Healing the Whole Man', 'Wholeness Through Christ' and 'Hearing God' Conferences,

the establishment of the **Covenant Vision School of Ministry** and its progress into the second term with a 50% increase in enrolment, the increase in attendance for our Friday night **Spiritual Growth Seminars**, the various ministry trips to Indonesia and Malaysia, the astounding testimonies that have been shared, the new leadership of the **Worship and Creative Arts ministry**, the vision for a **Marketplace ministry** etc, have been evident of these goals that the ministry had been working towards. Our God is truly the same God yesterday, today and forever. We felt such a joy and a strong sense that God was continuing to endorse the work of our ministry and that we had not lost sight of God's destiny for us.

Going forward, there are many exciting things that are in the pipeline for the ministry. As we seek to equip a chosen generation, we have already great plans for the next academic year of the **School of Ministry**, including the invitation of Dr Neal Patterson from New Zealand, previously the dean of Tung Ling bible school. We will also be conducting more general and interest seminars that will be open to the public.

As we seek to reach lost nations, we marvel at how God has opened new doors for us to minister in Australia and a ministry trip to Adelaide and Sydney is being planned for January 2008. Bro Francis will also be ministering in Malacca in December 2007. There are also plans to take our teachings to nations like Indonesia and Malaysia and we are praying for bahasa translators who would put their hands to the plough in making these available.



Celebrating 9 years of God's goodness!

It was certainly a significant day on the 9th of September 2007. This year we filled the Le Meridian Hotel ballroom with more than 400 people, including about 100 pastors and leaders from various churches, and celebrated the goodness and favour of God on the ministry for the past nine years.

Covenant Vision School of Ministry

Just eight months ago, CVSOM launched the Certificate in Practical Christian Ministry through its inaugural General Seminar, “Sonship”, by Bro Francis Khoo. And by the time this article is published, Term 2 would have just drawn to a close. Even in just two terms, so much has happened and so much has taken place; not only in the life of the School, but more significantly, in the lives of the students.

Through General Seminars, Interest Seminars and Equipping Courses, the School set out in March 2007 to fulfil its mission to equip the saints for the work of the ministry and to spur each on to deeper maturity in Christ. Sis Joan Hunter and Sis Teresa Seputis were invited to conduct the “Healing the Whole Man” and “Hearing God” conferences respectively. The Wholeness Through Christ Ministry Team from Canada ministered Inner Healing and Wholeness. The local seminars saw Bro Francis teaching “Sonship” and “Chinese Ancestral Worship and the Christian” and Bro Henson speaking on “Building Marriages on the Rock”. Students were put through the paces across six Equipping Courses conducted by Bro Francis, Ps Henry and Bro Henson. Through the Growth & Opportunity Weekends, the participants experienced God in new dimensions at the Encounter Weekend and the Silent Retreat.

The School saw enrolment grow from 20 students from various churches and denominations to the present strength of 50. Our recruitment and publicity efforts were further reinforced by the students’ testimonies and word-of-mouth recommendations to their own friends. Although the practical nature of the course required a lot more involvement and commitment, the students gained from the application of what they had learnt. They quickly realised that they had previously been only hearers and not doers of the Word. But once their faith was duly activated, the power of God began to move in their lives and situations. When that happened, a fresh excitement emerged and a deeper hunger for God resulted!

We give God all praise and glory for what He is doing through the School and in the lives of our students. By His grace, we are on the right track. Yet, this is only the beginning of something much bigger. Indeed, revival is coming and we are to be prepared for what God is going to do. God is not just looking for faithful church goers, but for faithful vessels who are willing to be sanctified and changed for His use and purposes. As we do our part in the School, we are more than confident that God will do His!

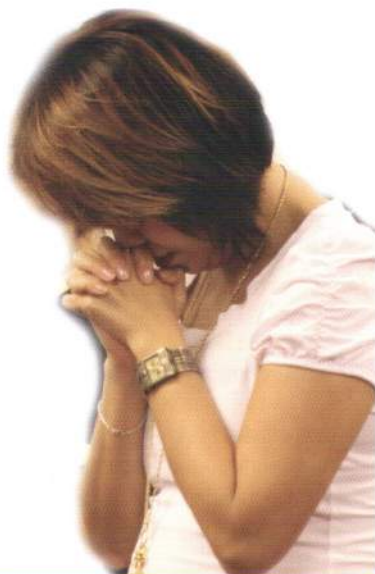

HEARING GOD

Teresa Seputis in Singapore - July 2007

One of the core goals of the ministry is **Equipping a Chosen Generation**, and over the last few years, we have organised numerous conferences with many great men and women of God. In 2007 alone, we had organised three major conferences. As a rule, we always sought God for not only the right time to hold conferences, but for His divine leading to invite the right people that will release teachings timely for that time and season. Bro Francis will testify that on more than one occasion, we have organised conferences with a title and no speaker, only to have one divinely placed right in our paths much later on. God has always come through for us and as a ministry, we trust Him implicitly when we have been called to organise a conference.

Immediately after the 'Healing the Whole Man' Conference with Joan Hunter in January this year, we felt the leading to hold another conference. In a conversation, a fellow brother mentioned Sis Teresa Seputis from the United States to Bro Francis and his heart leapt because one of the books she had written 'How to Hear God in a Noisy World', had touched his life and encouraged him many years back. Bro Francis got excited and in faith, he emailed Sis Teresa and invited her to Singapore. Her response was a resounding YES and that set in motion what was to culminate in a 2-day 'Hearing God' conference, a series of 'Prophetic Encounters' open meetings and a Pastors' and Leaders' meeting.

The 2-day 'Hearing God' conference held at Fairfield Methodist Church was organised with the aim to develop the spiritual skill of not just listening, but understanding what it means to hear God, leading to a more intimate relationship with the Lord. More than 300 people registered for the conference and Teresa Seputis delivered not just the biblical basis of hearing God, but challenged participants to activate their senses in practical exercises. Sis Teresa also taught on the barriers to hearing God and on how to identify what was of God and what was not. In one exercise, they were paired up and asked to hear what God was saying



to their partner. Many of them were pleasantly surprised at the accuracy of what they were hearing, and got all excited. Some later testified that they were encouraged to know that a hearing ear was not just for pastors and leaders, but for everyone.

Sis Teresa is not only a teacher, but moves in the prophetic. Throughout the conference and the four nights of 'Prophetic Encounters' meetings held at Fairfield Methodist Church, Covenant Presbyterian Church and at Covenant Vision Centre, Sis Teresa was constantly releasing prophecies to individuals God was leading her to speak to. She was speaking the heart and mind of God into the lives of these people and pointing them forward in their journeys in line with God's will. Many were touched and ministered to during the meetings.

The programme which lasted six days in all ended with a Pastors' and Leaders' meeting with Sis Teresa. More than a hundred pastors and leaders gathered at Covenant Vision Centre for a time of ministry and hearing from the Lord. Sis Teresa not only encouraged them, but challenged them to press on in their roles as shepherd to their sheep. Many of the attendees were seeking direction and some were tired and weary, but God used the session to speak to them personally and many of them were re-fired and ready to take their ministries to new and greater heights.

All in all, the conference was a resounding success and we saw God move powerfully in the meetings. All glory to God! We want to thank the host churches, Fairfield Methodist Church and Covenant Presbyterian Church, as well as other participating churches for their co-labour and partnership. Hallelujah!
