As we look forward in 2007, 1 Chronicles 12:32 reminds us of a group of people called the Children of Issachar. Although only 200 in numbers, they were a people who had an understanding of the times, positioned to receive revelation from God and were able to tell the brethren what to do. What an awesome privilege, but a tremendous responsibility. The direction and the future of a whole people were dependent on them being able to hear correctly and to interpret as well as to communicate the revelation they received accurately. Another very revealing aspect of the aforesaid Scripture is that "...all their brethren were at their commandment".

# MINISTRY FOCUS FOCUS

For 2007, the Lord had given us a clear word of three waves of evangelistic fervour bringing revival in the magnitude that we have never seen before, with miracles, wonders and signs confirming the sharing of the Word. The Lord had showed us that the year would begin with three months of record highs and lows in the stock, property and commodities markets. The events in the first three months of this year have established for us that the rest of the word must be true.

How are we as a Ministry to respond? As we prayerfully sought the Lord, He told us to **Bring them in, Build them** in wholeness through ministry, **Build them up** through teaching and equipping, **Bring them out** to minister in the Revival. These four Bs will be the main focus of our Ministry in 2007. In line with this, our Covenant Vision Ministry will be staging more evangelistic events as well as working on building wholeness, teaching and equipping the Body-of-Christ with Word-based, Spirit-led and Faith-filled teaching, training and ministry. 2007 will also be a pivotal year for us as we celebrate our 9th Anniversary.

We started 2007 with a Conference and Healing Services with Sis Joan Hunter. In March, we launched our Live The Life program under our **COVENANT VISION Marketplace Ministry**. We started April with a POWERHOUSE Revival Meeting with Bro Alvaro Sanchez and Apostle Rafael Shaw. We then launched our Certificate in Practical Christian Ministry under our **COVENANT VISION School of Ministry**. This was followed by a Teaching

and Equipping Seminar and personal counselling ministry with a team of six from Wholeness Through Christ Ministry, Canada.

We will continue to invite more overseas ministers to minister at our **COVENANT VISION Spiritual Growth Seminars**. Ps John Jacks, Ps Bob Mendelson, Ps Henry Wright and Bro John Cairns have all agreed to come. In July we have also scheduled a Hearing God Conference with Sis Teresa Seputis. At the end of this year, we will be bringing in Bro Steve Schultz and Bro Scott Webster to do a Teaching Seminar and Conference on Prophecy Today.

Also this year, on top of the monthly **TOUCH JESUS, HE HEALS!** Services at CVC, we had more Healing Services in various other Churches. We started with a service in Wesley Methodist Church as well as with monthly services at Acts Centre and Cairnhill Methodist Church. For the rest of this year, additional services have also been scheduled with Zion Full Gospel Church, Emmanuel Christian Church, Bedok Methodist Church and Gateway Christian Fellowship.

Also we will continue with our Missions Overseas Ministry. We have received many invitations from so many countries. Regrettably we are not able to accept them all. Our vision is that as we continue to raise more evangelists in our midst, one day we will be able to accept all of them. For this year the Lord also gave us the word to focus on Malaysia, Indonesia, Philippines and Thailand. We started the year with Ministry Teams going to Tanjung Pinang and Tanjung Uban in Indonesia. Crusades have also



already been scheduled for Iloilo City, Philippines, other parts of Indonesia as well as for Malaysia in Penang, Sungei Petani, Kulim and Malacca. We are also still in discussion and are presently working on various other invitations.

All these areas of work will require more workers in the harvest fields, volunteers as well as more full-time staff. As it is, we are already very short handed in so many areas. With the increasing number of meetings, we need more helpers in various areas and also more admin support as we continue to expand our teaching, equipping and training base. With more night sessions, we cannot expect our existing admin support staff to commit and give even more hours. Also this year we plan to expand our **COVENANT VISION Media and Resource Ministry**. More expertise and more equipment will be required, especially in the areas of audio and video recording for multimedia broadcasts as well as expansion of the work on radio and television. Bro Andrew has already drawn up a wish list for new equipment. As we move more into radio and television, another reality will be ongoing funds required to buy airtime.

Even as we grow, space is another consideration. We would need more counselling rooms, tutorial rooms, a library and lecture facilities. Also as attendance continues to grow, we would also need a bigger auditorium. A bigger auditorium will be a real blessing as we would then be able to organise conferences, seminars and teaching schools in-house. More finances will be needed to meet the various growing needs as well as the rising costs of operating in Singapore. We know that the hand of our God is not too short. He is a BIG God and as He has given us a BIG vision. we are believing Him for BIG provisions.

We continue to covet all your prayers, encouragement and support as we labour for the Lord.



# Let's Get **PRACTICAL**

## ***Covenant Vision School of Ministry offers the Certificate in Practical Christian Ministry***

Ask Bro Henson whether there is a need for yet another school in the Christian Education arena and his answer would be a resounding YES! But has not Singapore been blessed with the best apostles, prophets and teachers on the conference circuit? Have we not had enough of courses, courses and more courses? Why another School of Ministry then?

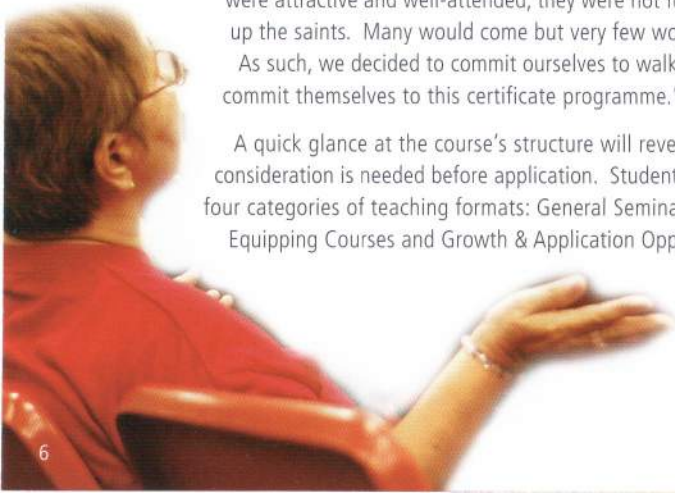
Whilst he readily agrees that there is no shortage of programmes and has also benefited from many of these offerings in the Christian market, Bro Henson observes that something is still sadly missing in the lives of many believers. The Head of Covenant Vision School of Ministry (CVSOM) notes, "What we often have is mere knowledge transfer which ends when the course ends. Like the rest of society, Christians are also caught up with the education and upgrading syndrome. This is not necessarily bad but when the focus is only on the acquisition of knowledge, it can and does often result in a false sense of security and even spirituality."

This explains why in the formulation and structuring of CVSOM's latest programme offering, much effort and consideration was given to making the course practical, hence its title, the Certificate in Practical Christian Ministry. "This is definitely not the first initiative of CVSOM," Bro Francis the founder of Covenant Vision comments,

"however, over the years, we found that although our stand-alone courses were attractive and well-attended, they were not fully effective in building up the saints. Many would come but very few would put it into practice.

As such, we decided to commit ourselves to walk with those who would commit themselves to this certificate programme."

A quick glance at the course's structure will reveal that careful consideration is needed before application. Students will be taken through four categories of teaching formats: General Seminars, Interest Seminars, Equipping Courses and Growth & Application Opportunities. Bro Henson

boldly declares, "At CVSOM, we want to play our part to equip the saints for ministry, to mature sons and daughters of God that they can and will manifest the glory of God. The individual must have this similar desire to be challenged and trained. Don't sign up if you're not ready to put your hand to the plow or to be radically changed by God."

So, does this mean that only those with a fulltime call need apply? "Certainly not!" exclaims Bro Henson, "this course is for fulltime Christians!" To cater to as many as possible, most seminars and classes are usually held on weeknights and weekends. Regular classes are conducted only once a week. Depending on what is manageable, one can opt for the FAST Track or the FLEXI Track. Course rates are also kept affordable. What's more, students can enter the programme at any point comfortable to their schedule and readiness.

As a trans-denominational ministry, Covenant Vision stands in a unique position to work alongside churches of all denominations. This means that CVSOM's Certificate in Practical Christian Ministry is open to all in the Body of Christ. As Bro Francis puts it, "This course is open to everyone and anyone with the desire to walk in the fullness of God and be a vessel of honour sanctified for the Master's use. We are excited at the opportunity to work even more closely with churches as we co-labour for the Kingdom of God."

**Enough said. It's time to get practical.**

# Extending the Kingdom in **CYBERSPACE**

## *Covenant Vision Media & Resource*

Covenant Vision Media and Resources had a rather bumpy start. As a faith ministry, we knew starting this ministry was going to test our faith even more. Bro Francis asked Bro Andrew, who had been in the advertising industry for 25 years, to head it. Bro Andrew would admit that he "... was reluctant as this was not my idea of full-time ministry... It was only after two mission trips to Mysore India and Davao City that [he] observed how much the village pastors wanted to be equipped and trained and how CVC could be a catalyst for their personal growth and their church growth. For the first time, the reality and power of media as a teaching and equipping tool grabbed [him]."

The task at hand was laborious, resource hungry and not to mention expensive. We had to trust God to provide **ALL**. Bro Andrew co-opted the help of a producer friend, and together with some personal equipment, they upgraded one of CVC's computers, purchased video editing software and we started the ministry. That was in 2005.

Today, the ministry operates with a seven member team. Each member of the team is assigned different roles: cameraman, audio engineer and producer who "call the shots".

Apart from documenting the messages of the Covenant Vision Spiritual Growth Seminars, and Touch Jesus, He Heals! Healing Services, it is our belief that we can establish a virtual Covenant Vision Ministry in cyberspace and on the airwaves mirroring the ministry's thrust in Singapore.

Our aim for the coming years is to produce programs for TV and radio stations, broadcasting our teaching and messages over the air and Internet, and produce an online library of messages. In addition to this, we hope that the courses run by the Covenant Vision School of Ministry would be delivered online through video conferencing. We could, with sufficient content, also run a 12-hour Internet TV station reaching the different time zones. These are all big plans, but we serve a **BIG GOD**, and we are praying that He will move us in greater and mightier ways, according to His will!

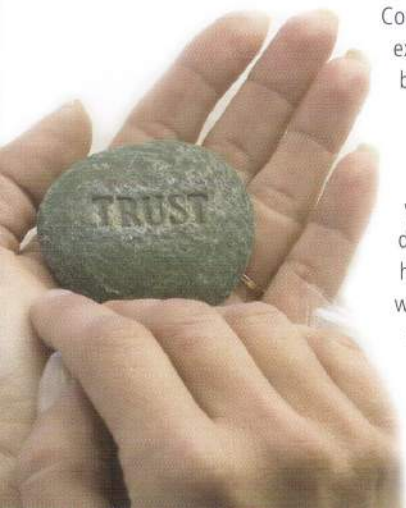

# MONDAY CHURCH

## *Covenant Vision Marketplace Ministry*

It has only been at the turn of this century that it has dawned upon the organised Church across the globe that the work of the ministry is to be carried out by the biblical Church [the body of Christ] and not just confined to "ordained" pastors.

The biblical Church is the "ecclesia" – the called-out ones, equipped and ready for battle; not just on Sundays to worship God but also between Sundays to "live the life" that God has imparted to every believer who has believed and received Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord into his/her life. Some believers appropriately term this as the "Monday Church".

This precisely is what the Covenant Vision Marketplace Ministry (CVMM) is all about – to teach, impart, encourage and equip believers to begin "Monday Church" wherever Christians may be, in the offices, with family and relatives in homes, in transitions, in transactions of goods and services – to sum up in one sentence, in the ordinary course of the believers' daily lives.

The common perception that the Marketplace refers only to corporate offices where businesses are conducted is too confining and narrow. CVMM prefers to have a broader definition, which is more inclusive than exclusive. The Marketplace is defined as a place or a situation where transactions take place involving our exchange of goods and services and/or favors and values. Why? This is because every believer is biblically expected to shine as "light in the world". The light that shines the brightest at home shines the furthest. Thus, it is paramount that the homemakers who typically are the biblical "helpmeets" ought not to be excluded. They also have a vital influential role to play, not only in helping the "breadwinners" but also as effective Christian witnesses to the people whom they come into contact with in the wet markets, supermarkets, cleaners, hawkers etc.

CVMM therefore begins each new batch of participants with a 3-part series entitled "Live The Life", which encompasses 3 levels of progression as believers live out their Christian witness in a "crooked and perverse world": Part 1 - Being a Witness in the Marketplace; Part 2 - Being a Leader in the Marketplace and Part 3 - Being a Commander in the Marketplace. This series is



designed to build up the inner life of the believer in preparation for his/her walk in the Marketplace "to shine as lights" for the Lord.

CVMM believes that without this equipping to build up their "inner life", believers in the Marketplace very often become discouraged, quit, backslide or suffer from "burnout".



By the third quarter of 2007, with the completion of the first batch of participants, CVMM will begin a Fellowship with the dual objectives of winning souls for Christ in the Marketplace as a channel to continue encouraging and equipping believers to preach and establish the Kingdom of God.

It is the firm conviction of CVMM that "Church" is not simply confined to Sundays, but ought also to be a "Monday Church", to "shine as lights" in the Marketplace!

Our passion and intension have always been to be Christ's ambassadors, representing Him in the Marketplace. We prayed and asked God to show us how we can build ourselves up within, how we should live our lives and how we can impact lives in the Marketplace with our own lives for His Kingdom. When we learnt about Bro Samuel Sim's call and passion for the Marketplace, our hearts leapt with joy because we knew it was a prayer answered.



Attending the CVMM meetings, Marcius and I have been led to a deeper understanding about God's truth about the importance of building and guarding our relationship with Him, our faith in Christ, understanding the whole man, our individual calling as His disciple, how we can fulfill His commission together as a body and many more practical issues in the Marketplace. Bro Samuel's teachings have deeply enriched and totally transformed our lives. Now, we challenge ourselves daily to live lives that glorify Him and continuously live out His Word in us.

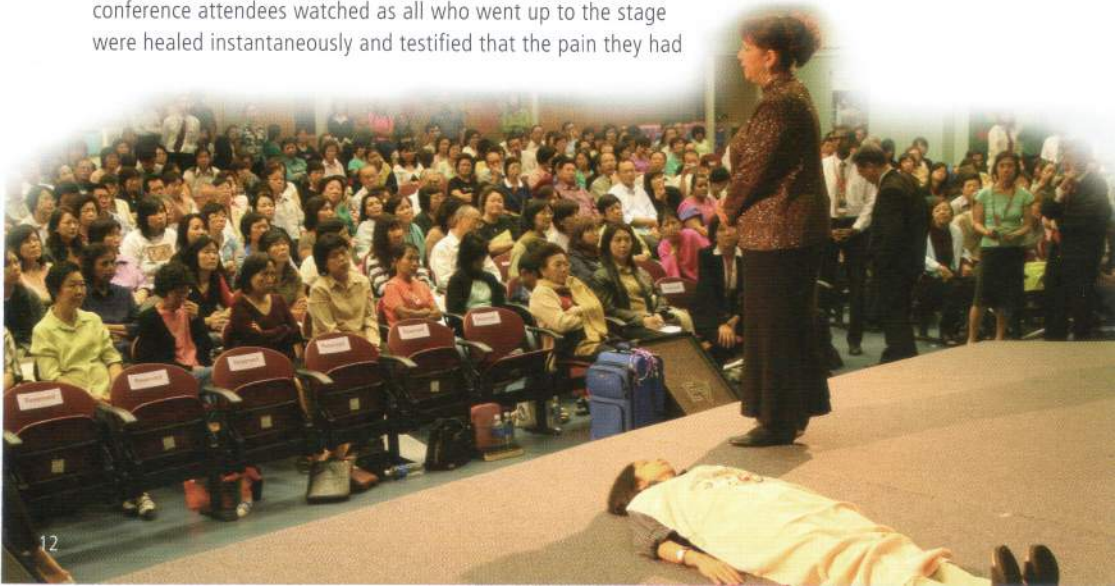
# HEALING THE WHOLE MAN

*Joan Hunter in Singapore - January 2007*

It was with much prayer and expectancy that we anticipated the **"Healing The Whole Man"** conference with Joan Hunter. Sis Joan taught with sincerity and with conviction. She prayed Eph 1:17-19 over the attendees at the conference -- that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ may give to us the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him, that the eyes of our understanding may be enlightened; that we may know the hope of His calling, the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints, and the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe, according to the working of His mighty power.

Sis Joan taught with conviction that ALL believers are to lay hands on the sick and the sick will recover (Mark 16:18). She shared passionately that all believers are to take the healing power of God outside the four walls of the church to the marketplace, to the grocery stores, to our workplace, to our schools, to every place where people are hurting and need God.

Sis Joan taught biblical principles on healing, on root causes of diseases and sicknesses, on the need for forgiveness, on the importance of repentance, on the power of the words we speak. She demonstrated with practical illustration that healing is not at all complicated. Healing and laying hands on the sick is all about knowing the authority that is in the name of Jesus and the promise that God heals. Sis Joan demonstrated to the conference attendees the power of God backing His word. She often asked for volunteers and demonstrated to the audience how to lay hands in faith and to see the sick healed. The conference attendees watched as all who went up to the stage were healed instantaneously and testified that the pain they had

God heals the inner man and binds up the broken hearted. It was particularly touching when Joan taught on forgiveness and asked for volunteers. One incredibly brave soul put up her hand. Joan prayed for her and led her in a prayer of forgiveness. There was an immediate and visible difference in her countenance after she was prayed for. There was joy and lightness in her face and she positively glowed.

On the last day of the conference, at the anointing service, it was awesome to see God's people hunger for Him. God's children turned to God and the Presence of God surrounded and wrapped every soul that lifted his/her heart to Him. The entire auditorium was silent as every heart received His precious anointing. Sis Joan Hunter and Bro Francis Khoo invited pastors and leaders to the stage. Sis Joan anointed each of these leaders and the power of God fell visibly in a mighty way.

The "Touch Jesus, He Heals" rallies in the evenings were packed! People turned up early. We saw God move as His Word promised. Faith rose as the congregation saw visible manifestation of God's glory and tangible proof of God's healing power. At one service, Sis Joan invited some members of the worship team to pray for the sick and they were healed. There was not only joy on the faces of those who were healed, but also amazement on the faces of the worship team members who had never prayed for the sick before!

I prayed and asked God to reveal this truth to me and told Him that I would serve Him. Soon, God started to provide various opportunities for me to serve Him. When I committed myself to be a vocalist with the worship team, God showed me I could reach CVC by 7pm by bridging time for me. Somehow work suddenly got done a lot quicker and I could leave early.

I always thought mission work was reserved for pastors and missionaries. How wrong I was. I now know that as long as we are humble and willing to let Him use us, God will do the work. Through our service, not only do our families experience God, His power, His grace and His love, we also build up our own faiths in Him, for we know He is near and that He cares for us.

1 Timothy 3:13 says those who have served well gain an excellent standing and great assurance in their faith in Christ Jesus. My prayer is that each of us will follow the way Jesus served, and that the Holy Spirit will reveal to each of us our role in God's master plan."
